COVID19 Policy & Guidelines

Objective

Oak Grove Church, Grove Kids Soccer Camp Guidelines outline the processes to reduce our players, coaches, volunteers and families potential exposure to the Coronavirus during activities associated with the 2020 Grove Kids Soccer Camp. These guidelines were developed to support compliance with orders and guidelines issued by the Federal Government, the State of MN and the City of Golden Valley. Oak Grove Church guidelines may change in relation to future changes to these government recommendations. In addition to changes that may be implemented to correspond with external changes, Oak Grove Church may adjust or revise policies that are found to need improvement after activities begin.

Scope

These guidelines apply to all Oak Grove Church, Grove Kids activities associated with the 2020 summer activities.

Applicable To

These guidelines apply to all coaches, families, players, and volunteers participating in Oak Grove Church, Grove Kids activities associated with the 2020 summer activities. All participants must review this document and acknowledge understanding before they will be permitted to participate in group activities.

Return to Play Procedures

1. All posted and published local and state regulated guidelines shall be followed.
2. All players (or their guardians) and coaches must complete and sign a COVID19 Waiver prior to participating in Grove Kids Soccer Camp.
3. Any person who is experiencing symptoms of sickness will be prohibited from attending the event/venue of play. Players who experiencing flu or COVID symptoms will need to meet the health criteria in order to return to play. (See Health Criteria Section below)
4. Oak Grove Church, Grove Kids Soccer Camp players, coaches and volunteers will take proactive steps to create and maintain social distancing environments, where possible.
5. Oak Grove Church will minimize player contact
 - All players and adult team personnel will wear masks when not on the field of play.
 - Enforce responsible distancing behavior during team breaks and in the play fields.
 - Prohibiting group huddles.
 - Prohibiting high fives, hugs, and handshakes.
 - Players and coaches will be asked to sanitize any shared equipment between uses.
6. Players must bring their own water bottle as there will be no shared water coolers or bottles. As summer months bring with them a potential risk of heat related illness, water needs to be plentiful.



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7. Oak Grove Church, Grove Kids encourages parents to supply their players with antibacterial wipes and/or hand sanitizer for disinfecting. Coaches and staff will also have sanitizing materials available and will be responsible to sanitize any shared playing equipment. Players and coaches are encouraged to sanitize their hands upon arrival to games and prior to departure.
8. All parents are strongly encouraged to wear PPE when (arriving, departing, etc.) Spectators are required to maintain a minimum of 6 feet from individuals not in their family. They are encouraged to wear face masks that cover their nose and mouth at ALL times when in attendance.
9. Oak Grove Church staff will be open to families' concerns regarding Covid-19. They are encouraged to contact a staff member to begin an open conversation.

If a player exhibits any of the current list of COVID symptoms they are not allowed to participate in Grove Kids Soccer Camp until one of the following things happen

- Negative COVID test result
- Fever free, without medicine, for 72 hours
- Absence of other identified symptoms, without medicine, for 48 hours (if fever was not one of the identified symptoms)

If a player test positive for the virus or is told they have the virus by a Dr., they must not participate in Grove Kids Soccer Camp.

If a member of the player's primary household tests positive for the virus or is told they have the virus by a Dr, the player is not allowed to participate in Grove Kids Soccer Camp.

If a member of the player's household exhibits symptoms, the player is not allowed to participate in Grove Kids Soccer Camp until that family member meets the following criteria.

- Negative COVID test result, or
- Fever free without medicine for 72 hours, &
- Absence of other identified symptoms, without medicine, for 48 hours (fever was not one of the identified symptoms)

If the player or a member of their household knows or believes they have been in proximity of someone who has symptoms, or tests positive but they don't live in the same household, the player is allowed to participate in Grove Kids Soccer Camp until/unless one of the above situations happens. Families are always empowered to choose to limit the player's involvement in this situation.
